

Course Overview

☉ PBIS4309/Reading III is designed to develop the ability of S1 Program students in the seventh semester to evaluate advanced English texts (7000 vocabularies), including narration, description, argumentation, either in the form of fiction or nonfiction texts. The ability in understanding and comprehending the texts covers the ability of literal, inferential and evaluation. To take this course the students have to take PBIS4208/Reading II as the prerequisite course.

PBIS4309/Reading III consists of 9 modules. Module 1 discusses about critical reading that will train the students to develop their ability in critical reading. Module 2 will invite the students to discuss and develop their reading skill in understanding the illustration texts. Module 3 trains the students to develop their ability in evaluating comparison and contrast text. Module 4 trains the students to develop their ability in evaluating analysis texts. Module 5 discusses about cause and effect text to make the students be able to analyze and comprehend the cause and effect text. In Module 6 the students learn about narration text and develop their skill in analyzing and comprehending narration texts. In Module 7 the students learn about exposition text and develop their skill in analyzing and comprehending exposition texts. Module 8 and 9 help the students to develop their ability in analyzing and comprehending the description and argumentation texts.

To help the students in learning this course there are exercises and formative test in every module that will help the students to evaluate their ability in reading advanced texts. Therefore the students are asked to do the exercises first then check their answer with the key exercises and key for formative test provided.
